Pastor's Perspective | September 2022

For everything there is a season, and a time for every matter under heaven

Ecclesiastes 3:1

I shared on my first Sunday with you in worship that it was good to be back here at First Lutheran Church in Hibbing ... and not just "back," but it was - and is - good to be home. While it might be exceptional, it certainly isn't unheard of for a pastor to return to a parish they had previously served. And in my first weeks with you, I have already heard a lot about "coming back" and "returning" and even some "getting back to normal" comments. And yes, being back brings a lot of familiar feelings

... and it's good to reminisce and catch up, for sure

and I find myself in some

nostalgic conversations with folks

But we know that we have to not just look forward, but we need to move forward as a church. I've already met with the council and have talked with other members about things we can do that will help us renew First Lutheran Church together. That's our immediate focus: renewing our relationships, our identity as a congregation, and our mission as church.

Renewing our relationships - with each other and with God - happens in Word and Sacrament worship, in fellowship, in learning, and serving together. First Lutheran Church is the kind of community people want to be a part of because there is a genuine spirit of hospitality and kindness here. Renewing our identity as a congregation, as we come out of a long period of Covid closure and multiple pastoral transitions, will take time and effort as we explore what God's plan is for First Lutheran. But know this: we are a vital

> congregation with gifts to offer, and I think that hasn't always been the message we're used to hearing. Renewing our mission is all about looking for ways to live out the baptismal promises: living life together, worshiping God, proclaiming Christ in word and deed, caring for others and the

world, and working for justice and peace. How is God calling us, First Lutheran Church, to be part of this work?

I am so grateful to be "back" with you as we look forward to this time of renewal. Thank you, once again to your Call Committee - to Stephanie Skraba, Paul Tokarczyk, Barb Bautch, and Paul Stavnes - who worked with the Council and the Bishop's Office to make this exceptional call a possibility. And thanks to all of you - the people who are First Lutheran Church - for trusting me with the Word and Sacrament Ministry among you, and for calling me to servant leadership in this community and for this new season.





Old Business— New copier is here and running. Suggested to do the new directory next spring as people are coming back, may check out Emily Law, tabled to talk to others.


